# THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2006

### MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill would amend the Legal Practitioners Law (2003 Revision) in order to provide for an increase in the operational licence fees payable by firms or recognised bodies employing six or more attorneys-at-law. To achieve this, clause 2 of the Bill would repeal and replace the Fourth Schedule.

1. This Law may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Law, 2006.

Short title

2. The Legal Practitioners Law (2003 Revision) is amended by repealing the Fourth Schedule and substituting the following:

### **Operational Licence Fees**

Firm/recognised body-

A firm or recognised body employing 1 – 5 attorneys-at- Exempt law

A firm or recognised body employing 6-10 attorneys-at- \$20,000 law

A firm or recognised body employing $11-15$ attorneysat-law	\$40,000
A firm or recognised body employing $16-20$ attorneysat-law	\$60,000
A firm or recognised body employing 21 – 25 attorneys-at-law	\$200,000
A firm or recognised body employing $26-30$ attorneysat-law	\$250,000
A firm or recognised body employing $31-40$ attorneysat-law	\$300,000
A firm or recognised body employing $41-50$ attorneysat-law	\$350,000
A firm or recognised body employing 51 or more attorneys-at-law	\$400,000"
