GOVERNMENT FEES LAW

(2011 Revision)

1. This Law may be cited as the Government Fees Law (2011 Revision).

2. Where Government is asked or requested to perform any of the administrative acts or duties prescribed in the Schedule, the Governor in Cabinet shall estimate the cost to the revenue involved in such performance and require that a fee equivalent to that cost be charged to the individual benefiting therefrom, and such fee shall be enforceable as a civil debt.

3. The Governor in Cabinet may, from time to time, by Order amend, add to or so revoke the Schedule.
