**THE CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE) (PUROS DE CAIMAN  
LIMITED) REGULATIONS, 2007**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 20, 21 and 73 of the Customs Law (2006 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following regulations-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Puros De Caiman Limited) Regulations, 2007. Citation
2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the place described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse. Bonded warehouse
3. The person named in Schedule 3 is nominated to be the warehouse keeper of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2. Warehouse keeper

**SCHEDULE 1**

**The Bonded Warehouse**

The part of the building located at Block OPY Parcel 127 Unit # 9, Royal Watler Cruise Terminal, Harbour Drive, George Town, consisting of an area of 373 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for a bonded warehouse made by Robert Hurlstone of Puros De Caiman Limited on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2007.

**SCHEDULE 2**

**The Conditions**

1. That a bond in the sum of \$75,000 with a recognized bank or insurance company be taken out to cover the duty risk in respect of goods in the bonded warehouse at any time.
2. That no goods, other than cigars which are the property of Puros De Caiman Limited shall be stored in the bonded warehouse.
