THE CONSULAR FEES (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012, S.I. 2012 NO. 1752

NOTICE is hereby given that the Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 2012, S.I. 2012 No. 1752, was made on 10th July 2012, and came into force on 3rd September 2012.

The Explanatory Note of the Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 2012 is as follows:

“EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Consular Fees Order 2012. The fees for passport applications made in the UK are being reduced by £5 for adult applications and by £3 for child applications. Fast track applications are reduced by £9.50. Premium and fast-track collect adult applications are reduced by £1.50. Premium and fast-track collect child applications are reduced by £3.00. There is no change to the fee for a collective passport.

A full regulatory impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.”.
