The Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 are amended in regulation 4 as follows -<br>(a) in paragraph (1)(c) by deleting the word “six” and substituting the word “four”; and<br>(b) by repealing paragraph (2).  | Amendment of regulation 4 of the Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 - establishment of Public Transport Appeals Tribunal |
| 3. The Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 are amended in regulation 6 by repealing paragraph (6) and substituting the following paragraph -<br><br>“ (6) Four members of the Appeals Tribunal, including the chairman, present at any meeting shall form a quorum.”. | Amendment of regulation 6 of the Traffic (Public Transport Appeals Tribunal) Regulations, 2004 - meetings of Appeals Tribunal                       |
