THE UNITED NATIONS SANCTIONS (OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) (REVOCATIONS) ORDER 2012, S.I. 2012 NO. 2592

NOTICE is hereby given that the United Nations Sanctions (Overseas Territories) (Revocations) Order 2012, S.I. 2012 No. 2592, was made on 17th October 2012, was laid before Parliament on 24th October 2012 and came into force on 14th November 2012.

The United Nations Sanctions (Overseas Territories) (Revocations) Order 2012 extends to specified Overseas Territories, including the Cayman Islands, by virtue of Article 1(2) of the Order.

The Explanatory Note of the United Nations Sanctions (Overseas Territories) (Revocations) Order 2012 is as follows:

“EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes The Serbia and Montenegro (United Nations Prohibition of Flights) (Dependent Territories) Order 1992, The Serbia and Montenegro (United Nations Sanctions) (Dependent Territories) Order 1993, The Former Yugoslavia (United Nations Sanctions) (Dependent Territories) Order 1994, The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (United Nations Sanctions) (Dependent Territories) Order 1998, The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (United Nations Sanctions) (Dependent Territories) (Amendment) Order 1999, The Eritrea and Ethiopia (United Nations Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) Order 2000, and The Eritrea and Ethiopia (United Nations Sanctions) (Overseas Territories) (Amendment) Order 2000. These Orders ceased to have effect on the termination of the United Nations sanctions measures which they implemented. This Order formally revokes the Orders.”.
