# CUSTOMS (BONDED WAREHOUSE) (ISLAND MAN RUM SHOP) REGULATIONS, 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Cabinet by section 73 of the Customs Law (2003 Revision) the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited the Customs (Bonded Warehouse) (Island Short title Man Rum Shop) Regulations, 2005.
- 2. Subject to compliance with the conditions specified in Schedule 2, the Prescribed warehouse premises described in Schedule 1 is a bonded warehouse.
- 3. The persons named in Schedule 3 are nominated to be the warehouse Warehouse keeper keepers of the warehouse referred to in regulation 2.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### The Bonded Warehouse

That part of the building located at Block 106E, Parcel 39, Watering Place, Cayman Brac consisting of an area of 750 square feet more particularly delineated on the plan attached to the application for approval of a bonded warehouse made by Maria McKeever on 8th, November, 2004.

#### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **Conditions**

- 1. That a bond in the sum of \$20,000 with a recognised bank or insurance company be taken out to cover the duty risk in respect of goods in the bonded warehouse at any time.
- 2. That no goods, other than spirits which are the property of Island Man Rum Shop, be stored in the bonded warehouse.
