PROCLAMATION NO. 2 OF 2004

BY HIS EXCELLENCY BRUCE H. DINWIDDY, COMPANION OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF ST MICHAEL AND ST GEORGE, GOVERNOR OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

WHEREAS section 47(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the Governor may at any time, by Proclamation, prorogue or dissolve the Legislative Assembly:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce H. Dinwiddy, CMG, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 47(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands HEREBY PROCLAIM that the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be prorogued as from Thursday, the 1st day of July, 2004.

WHEREAS section 46(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the sessions of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at such places and begin at such times as the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce H. Dinwiddy, CMG, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 46(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands HEREBY PROCLAIM that a session of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at the Legislative Assembly Building in George Town, in the Island of Grand Cayman, beginning at 10:00 am, on Friday, the 2nd day of July, 2004.
