In exercise of the powers conferred on the Legislative Assembly by subsection (1) of section 31 of Schedule 2 to the Cayman Islands (Constitution) Order, 1972, as amended, and in accordance with Standing Order 87 of the legislative Assembly Standing Orders (1997 Revision), the following amendment to the Legislative Assembly Standing Orders (1997 Revision) was made by the Legislative Assembly on 20 February 2002:

Amendment to Standing Order  
32 – Time and manner of speaking

Standing Order 32(6) is amended by the deletion thereof and the substitution of the following –

“No Member at any one time may speak on any debate for any period of time which, exclusive of breaks, exceeds two hours:”.
