**A LAW TO AMEND THE COMPLAINTS COMMISSIONER LAW, 2003  
TO ENABLE SUPPORT STAFF OF THE COMMISSIONER TO BE  
APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE MANAGEMENT LAW; AND FOR INCIDENTAL  
AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Complaints Commissioner (Amendment) Law, 2005.

Short title and commencement

(2) This Law shall come into force concurrently with the coming into force of the Public Service Management Law, 2005.

Law No. 27 of 2005

2. The Complaints Commissioner Law, 2003 is amended in section 6 (2) by repealing the word "Governor" and substituting therefor the words "Commissioner in accordance with the Public Service Management Law, 2005".
