**A LAW TO AMEND THE GRAND COURT LAW (1995 REVISION) TO
ENABLE SUPPORT STAFF FOR THE GRAND COURT TO BE
APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF OFFICER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
PUBLIC SERVICE MANAGEMENT LAW; AND FOR INCIDENTAL
AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Grand Court (Amendment) Law, 2005. Short title and
commencement
(2) This Law shall come into force concurrently with the Public Service Management Law, 2005. Law No. 27 of 2005

2. The Grand Court Law (1995 Revision), hereinafter called the principal Law, is amended by the insertion in the appropriate alphabetical placing of the following definition - Amendment of section 2
- Definitions

‘ “chief officer” means the chief officer of the judicial administration appointed under section 3 of the Public Management and Finance Law (2003 Revision);’.

The Grand Court (Amendment) Law, 2005

Amendment of section 7
- Officers of the Court

3. The principal Law is amended in section 7 -

- (a) in subsection (1) by repealing the words “The Governor, in accordance with the Public Service Commission Law (Revised)” and substituting therefor the words “The chief officer, in accordance with the Public Service Management Law, 2005,”;
- (b) in subsection (2) by repealing the word “Governor” and substituting therefor the word “chief officer”.
