A BILL FOR A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC LAW (2003 REVISION) FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING PROVISION FOR THE LICENSING OF OVERSIZE VEHICES; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS

THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2010

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Traffic Law (2003 Revision).

Clause 1 provides the short title.

Clause 2 repeals and substitutes the definition of the term "oversize truck" by changing some figures while retaining the number and sequence of paragraphs in the principal Law. Effectively, paragraph (a) deletes "eight feet" and replaces it with "eight feet six inches". Paragraph (b) remains unchanged at fourteen feet. Paragraph (c) deletes "sixty thousand pounds" and replaces it with "sixty-six thousand pounds", while paragraph (d) deletes "forty feet" and inserts "forty-five feet".

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Law, 2010. Short title

The Traffic Law (2003 Revision) is amended in section 2 by deleting the definition of the words "oversize truck" and substituting the following definition Revision) - definitions

Amendment of section 2 of the Traffic Law (2003

""oversize vehicle" means a vehicle in any of the following categories -

- (a) having an overall width in excess of eight feet and six inches;
- (b) having an overall travelling height in excess of fourteen
- (c) having a maximum gross weight in excess of sixty-six thousand pounds; and
- (d) towing a trailer the length of which exceeds forty-five feet;".
