## A LAW TO AMEND THE NATIONAL ARCHIVE AND PUBLIC RECORDS LAW, 2007 AS A CONSEQUENCE OF THE CREATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICE OF MINISTER CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR FINANCE; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the National Archive and Public Records <sup>Short title</sup> (Amendment) Law, 2010.

2. The National Archive and Public Records Law, 2007 is amended in section 5(1) by repealing paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraph -

"(d) a nominee of the member of the Cabinet charged with responsibility for finance;".
