A LAW TO AMEND THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE (THIRD PARTY RISKS) LAW (2004 REVISION) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRESCRIBING THAT AN APPLICANT FOR A VEHICLE LICENCE SHALL PRODUCE A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE IN HIS NAME, IN THE NAME OF AN INSURED WHO HAS INCLUDED THE APPLICANT AS A DRIVER OF THAT VEHICLE FOR PURPOSES OF INSURANCE OR IN THE NAME OF BOTH.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Insurance (Third Party Risks) (Amendment) Law, 2006. Short title

2. The Motor Vehicle Insurance (Third Party Risks) (2004 Revision) is amended in section 6 by deleting the words “certificate of insurance” where they first occur and substituting the words “certificate of insurance in his name, in the name of an insured who has included the applicant as a driver of that vehicle for purposes of insurance or in the name of both”.
