**A LAW TO AMEND THE ANIMALS LAW (2003 REVISION) TO MAKE
PROVISION FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE GRAND CAYMAN
BLUE IGUANA (*CYCLURA LEWISI*) AND THE CAYMAN BRAC AND
LITTLE CAYMAN ROCK IGUANA (*CYCLURA NUBILA
CAYMANENSIS*); AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED
PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Animals (Amendment) Law, 2010.

Short title

2. The Animals Law (2003 Revision) is amended by repealing section 80 and substituting the following section -

Repeal and substitution
of section 80 of the
Animals Law (2003
Revision) - protected
animals

"Protected animals

80. The Grand Cayman Blue Iguana (*Cyclura lewisi*), the Cayman Brac and Little Cayman Rock Iguana (*Cyclura nubila caymanensis*) and all non-domestic birds other than game birds are protected animals."
