THE PATENTS AND TRADE MARKS (FEES) REGULATIONS, 2006

The Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Patents and Trade Marks Law (1999 Revision), makes the following regulations –

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Patents and Trade Marks (Fees) Citation and commencement Regulations, 2006.

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st July, 2006.
- 2. The Schedule to the Patents and Trade Marks Law (1999 Revision) is amended by deleting Parts 1, 2 and 3 and substituting the following Parts -
