MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Public Service Management Law (2007 Revision) to repeal section 48, being the section which deals with the appointment and dismissal of police officers. An amendment is also made to section 6 to remove the reference to section 48. The amendment is consequential upon the enactment of the revised Police Law which makes provision for, inter alia, the appointment and dismissal of police officers.
