## A LAW TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE (INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION) LAW (2004 REVISION) RESPECTING THE TRANSFER OF WITNESSES; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

This Law may be cited as the Criminal Justice (International Cooperation) (Amendment) Law, 2010.

The Criminal Justice (International Cooperation) Law (2004 Revision) is amended in section 3 by-

- (a) deleting the word "and" at the end of paragraph (h);
- (b) deleting the full-stop at the end of paragraph (i) and substituting a semicolon:
- (c) inserting after paragraph (i) the word "and"; and
- (d) inserting after paragraph (i) the following paragraph-
  - "(j) facilitating the voluntary transfer of witnesses.".
