PROCLAMATION NO. 3 OF 2013

WHEREAS section 83(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the sessions of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at such places and begin at such times as the Governor may from time to time by proclamation appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Duncan Taylor, CBE, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the said section 83(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands HEREBY PROCLAIM that a session of the Legislative Assembly of the Cayman Islands shall be held at the Legislative Assembly Building in George Town, in the Island of Grand Cayman beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, the Twenty-ninth day of May, 2013.
