A BILL FOR A LAW TO APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2010

THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (JULY 2009 TO JUNE 2010) BILL, 2013

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

It is necessary to enact in respect of each financial year an Appropriation Law giving the Governor in Cabinet authority to incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing necessary for all services of the Government in that year in the manner directed by the Legislature.

This Bill is for Supplementary Appropriations for the financial year ending 30 June 2010 and seeks approval for changes to expenditure under the several heads of expenditure set out in the Schedule, and charges the expenditure on the revenue and funds of the Islands.

A BILL FOR A LAW TO APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2010

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (July 2009 to Short title June 2010) Law, 2013.
- 2. The Governor in Cabinet may incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing for the financial year ending 30 June 2010 in the amount and for the respective purposes set forth in the Schedule.
