THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (JULY 2012 TO JUNE 2013) BILL, 2013

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

It is necessary to enact in respect of each financial year an Appropriation Law giving the Governor in Cabinet authority to incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing necessary for all services of the Government in that year in the manner directed by the Legislature.

This Bill is for Supplementary Appropriations for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 and seeks approval for changes to expenditure under the several heads of expenditure set out in the Schedule, and charges the expenditure on the revenue and funds of the Islands.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (July 2012 to Short title June 2013) Law, 2013.

2. The Governor in Cabinet may incur executive expenses, acquire executive Appropriation authority assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing for the financial year ending 30 June 2013 in the amount and for the respective purposes set forth in the Schedule.
