The Governor in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9(2) of the Liquor Licensing Law (2000 Revision) makes the following order -

1. This order may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Distributor, Package and Retail Licences) Order, 2004. Citation

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Liquor Licensing Board may grant new distributor, package and retail licences in the Islands during the quarterly session which commences in December 2004 and the Board shall consider all applications received by the Board during such session. Applications for distributor, package and retail licences

(2) The Liquor Licensing Board shall not grant a liquor licence for the disposal of intoxicating liquor or spirits by a gas station.
