**A LAW TO AMEND THE HEALTH SERVICES AUTHORITY LAW
(2003 REVISION); AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED
PURPOSES**

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Health Services Authority (Amendment) Law, 2004. Short title

2. The Health Services Authority Law (2003 Revision), in this Law referred to as “the principal Law”, is amended by repealing section 12 and substituting the following section- Amendment of the Health Services Authority Law (2003 Revision) – repeal of section 12 and substitution-immunity

“Immunity

12. Neither the Authority, nor any director or employee of the Authority, shall be liable in damages for anything done or omitted in the discharge of their respective functions or duties unless it is shown that the act or omission was in bad faith.”.

3. The principal Law is amended by inserting after section 12 the following section- Amendment of the principal Law– insertion of section 12A- indemnity

“Indemnity

12A. The Authority shall indemnify a director against all claims, damages, costs, charges or expenses incurred by that director in the discharge of his functions or duties except claims, damages, costs, charges or expenses caused by the bad faith of that director.”.

Amendment of Schedule
1- property to be vested
in the Authority.

4. The principal Law is amended in Schedule 1 by repealing the words “Dr. Hortor Memorial site” and the words “Block 15C Parcel 28”.
