## MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Complaints Commissioner Law, 2003 to make certain changes in the appointment of support staff of the Commissioner.

Clause 1 provides the short title and makes provision in respect of the commencement of the legislation.

Clause 2 amends section 6 (2) of the principal Law by deleting the Governor as the appointing authority for supporting officers and empowers the Commissioner to carry out this function in accordance with the Public Service Management Law, 2005.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Complaints Commissioner Short title and commencement (Amendment) Law, 2005.

(2) This Law shall come into force concurrently with the coming into Law No. of 2005 force of the Public Service Management Law, 2005.

2. The Complaints Commissioner Law, 2003 is amended in section 6 (2) by repealing the word "Governor" and substituting therefor the words "Commissioner in accordance with the Public Service Management Law, 2005".
