**THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2005**

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill amends the Summary Jurisdiction Law (2004 Revision).

Clause 1 makes provision for the short title and commencement.

Clause 2 inserts a definition of “chief officer”.

Clause 3 enables the chief officer rather than the Governor to appoint clerks, marshals, bailiffs and other officers as may be required. Further, it enables the chief officer, in place of the Governor, to order the giving of security for fidelity in the performance by such officers of their duties.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Amendment) Law, 2005. Short title and commencement
- (2) This Law shall come into operation concurrently with the coming into force of the Public Service Management Law, 2005. Law No.      of 2005
2. The Summary Jurisdiction Law (2004 Revision), hereinafter called the principal Law, is amended in section 2 by the insertion in the appropriate alphabetical place of the following - Amendment of section 2  
- Definitions
- ‘ “chief officer” means the chief officer of the judicial administration appointed in accordance with section 3 of the Public Management and Finance Law (2003 Revision);’.
