**A LAW TO AMEND THE COMPANIES LAW (2004 REVISION) TO
INCREASE THE FEES FOR STRIKING COMPANIES OFF THE
REGISTER; FOR FILING RESOLUTIONS, NOTICES, RETURNS AND
OTHER DOCUMENTS; FOR ISSUING CERTIFICATES; FOR
PROVIDING COPIES OF DOCUMENTS; FOR GENERAL SEARCHES;
AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

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| 1. This Law may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Law, 2006 and shall come into force on 1 st July, 2006. | Short title and commencement |
| 2. The Companies Law (2004 Revision), hereinafter called “the principal Law”, is amended in section 175 (2) by deleting the words “twenty dollars” and substituting the words “twenty-five dollars”. | Amendment of section 175- Company not operating may be struck off register |
| 3. The principal Law is amended in section 219 (1) -

(b) in paragraph (b) by deleting “\$41” and substituting “\$82”;
(c) in paragraph (c) by deleting “\$41” and substituting “\$82”; and
(d) in paragraph (d) by deleting “\$15” and substituting “\$ 25”.</div> | Amendment of section 219 - fees in lieu of other provisions |
