## THE LIQUOR LICENSING (RESTAURANT, WINE AND BEER LICENCES) ORDER, 2006

The Governor in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9(2) of the Liquor Licensing Law (2000 Revision) makes the following order -

1. This order may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Restaurant, Wine and Beer Licences) Order, 2006.

Citation

2. (1) Subject to subparagraph (3), the Liquor Licensing Board may grant new restaurant licences, and wine and beer licences in the Islands during the quarterly session which commences in December 2006, and the Board shall consider all applications received by the Board during such session.

Applications for restaurant, wine and beer licences

- (2) Subject to subparagraph (3), during the period October 2006 to December 2006, the Liquor Licensing Board may grant temporary restaurant licences, and wine and beer licences in the Islands at any meeting held by the Board under section 15 of the Law; and the Board shall consider all applications for the grant of such temporary licences, received by the Board during any such meeting.
- (3) The Liquor Licensing Board shall not grant a liquor licence for the disposal of intoxicating liquor or spirits by a gas station.
