A BILL FOR A LAW TO AMEND THE MARRIAGE LAW (2009 REVISION) SO AS TO INCREASE THE FEE RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENCES; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

## THE MARRIAGE (AMENDMNENT) BILL, 2009

## **OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill seeks to amend the Marriage Law (2009 Revision) so as to effect certain changes relating to special licences.

Clause 2(a) repeals and substitutes section 22(3) so that upon application for a special licence the fee payable shall increase from one hundred and fifty dollars to two hundred dollars. The two hundred dollars represents an application fee of fifty dollars (which shall be non-refundable) and one hundred and fifty dollars (which shall be refunded if the application is refused).

Clause 2(b) amends section 22(5) to remove the requirement that a special licence shall bear a stamp of ten dollars.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Marriage (Amendment) Law, 2009.

- 2. The Marriage Law (2009 Revision) is amended in section 22-
  - (a) by repealing subsection (3) and substituting the following-
- (2009 Revision) Special Licences
  - "(3) The application shall be accompanied by-
    - (a) an application fee of fifty dollars, which shall be nonrefundable;
    - (b) a licence fee of one hundred and fifty dollars, which shall be refunded if the application is refused.";
  - (b) in subsection (5) by repealing at the end of the subsection the words "and such special licence shall bear a stamp of the value of ten dollars".
