## A LAW TO AMEND THE PARLIAMENTARY PENSIONS LAW (2010 REVISION) TO VARY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE PAYMENT OF A PARLIAMENTARY PENSION TO FORMER MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY WHO ARE OTHERWISE INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE PENSION; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Parliamentary Pensions (Amendment) Law, 2016.

2. The Parliamentary Pensions Law (2010 Revision) is amended in section 20 by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection -

" (1A) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a pension shall be payable to any person who served as a member or a Speaker for one full parliamentary term at any time during the period commencing on  $1^{st}$  October, 1959 and ending on  $23^{rd}$  August, 2004.".
