# ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

#### **GOVERNMENT FEES LAW**

#### (2016 Revision)

1. This Law may be cited as the Government Fees Law (2016 Revision).

Short title

2. Where Government is asked or requested to perform any of the administrative acts or duties prescribed in the Schedule, the Cabinet shall estimate the cost to the revenue involved in such performance and require that a fee equivalent to that cost be charged to the individual benefiting therefrom, and such fee shall be enforceable as a civil debt.

Government may charge fees for the performance of certain acts or duties

3. The Cabinet may, from time to time, by Order amend, add to or revoke the Schedule.
