**THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (STUDENTS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Legal Practitioners Law (2015 Revision), the Cabinet, after consultation with the Legal Advisory Council, makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Students) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016. Citation
2. The Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (2015 Revision), in these Regulations referred to as “the principal Regulations”, are amended by repealing regulation 10. Repeal of regulation 10 of the Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (2015 Revision) - publication of passes
3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 12 by deleting the words “Regulations 9(2), (3), (4), (5), (8) and (9), and 10 shall apply,” and substituting the words “Regulations 9(2), (3), (4), (5), (8) and (9) shall apply,”. Amendment of regulation 12 of the Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (2015 Revision) - application of regulations 9 and 10
4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 17 by inserting after subregulation (2), the following subregulation -

 “(3) Where, in making an application under subregulation (1), it is necessary to seek confirmation by the Council of the equivalence of a professional qualification, evidence shall be adduced establishing that the applicant also holds -

 (a) a Cayman Qualifying Law Degree, as set out in regulation 27D(1); or
 (b) a qualification which in the opinion of the Council is equivalent to a Cayman Qualifying Law Degree; and

the qualifications referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) shall be classified as at least a Lower Second Class degree, or equivalent.”.
