A LAW TO AMEND THE EVIDENCE LAW (2011 REVISION) TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE GIVING OF EVIDENCE THROUGH TELEVISION LINKS AT TRIALS OF OFFENCES THAT ARE TRIABLE ONLY SUMMARILY; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Evidence (Amendment) Law, 2017.

2. The Evidence Law (2011 Revision) is amended in section 37(2) by inserting after paragraph (c) the following paragraph -

"(ca) summary trials of Category C offences;".

3. (1) Where, at the date of commencement of this Law, any trial or any proceedings in respect of an offence are pending before a court, the trial or proceedings shall, on and after that date, be dealt with in all respects under the new Law (irrespective of when the offence was committed) and the provisions of the new Law are to apply accordingly.
