In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Legal Practitioners Law (2015 Revision), the Cabinet, after consultation with the Legal Advisory Council, makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Students) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2017. Citation

2. The Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (2015 Revision) are amended in regulation 20 as follows - Amendment of regulation  
20 of the Legal  
Practitioners (Students)  
Regulations (2015  
Revision) - employment  
under Articles

- (a) in subregulation (2)(a) by deleting the words “section 15(1) to (4)” and substituting the words “section 16(1) to (4) of the Law”; and
- (b) by inserting after subregulation (2) the following subregulations -
  - “(2A) Subject to the approval of -
    - (a) the Council, in accordance with subregulation (2)(b);
    - and
    - (b) the attorney-at-law to whom the person is articulated,

a person who has successfully completed three months of the required eighteen months of articles, may apply in the prescribed manner for a Judicial Clerkship (usually for a period of one month) and if successful, that period of one month or such other period as the Council may, in its discretion permit to be so reckoned, shall be treated as a period of employment with the attorney-at-law to whom the person is articulated and shall be good service under the articles.

(2B.)For the purposes of subregulation (2A), “Judicial Clerkship” means a period of training, usually for a period of one month, under the supervision of a Judge or Magistrate.”.
