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Foreword

This financial report presents the unaudited financial information, along with analysis and commentary, for the first fiscal quarter ended 31 March 2018 for Core Government. The results of Core Government along with, Statutory Authorities and Government Owned Companies (SAGC's) are shown in the Statement of Financial Performance.

The information contained herein is based on records obtained from the General Ledger of the Government's financial management system. It is also based on the representations and judgments provided by the Chief Financial Officers of Ministries, Portfolios, Offices, and Statutory Authorities and Government Companies (SAGC's).

Effective 1 January 2018 the Government transitioned to a 12-month financial year (1 January – 31 December).

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Executive Summary

The financial results of the Core Government for the three month period ended 31 March 2018 (the period) shows a \$199.0 million surplus and bank balances of \$616.7 million in cash and deposits.

The \$199.0 million surplus was \$34.1 million higher than the \$164.9 million surplus the budget anticipated for the period. This was primarily due to higher coercive revenues (a positive variance of \$13.5 million) complimented by lower levels of expenditures in Personnel Costs (a variance of \$4.8 million) and Supplies and Consumables (a variance of \$7.0 million) within Core Government.

The Government experienced favourable variances to budget in all revenue lines, albeit not to the extent accomplished in coercive revenues. Sales of goods and services and investment revenue exceeded the budget by \$1.3 million and \$1.4 million, respectively. In addition to the favourable variances in Personnel Costs and Supplies and Consumables, there were also lower Other Operating Expenses (a variance of \$1.0 million) and higher than anticipated gains on Financial and Non-financial Instruments (a variance of \$1.5 million).

Vigilance and strict adherence to policy have yielded significant improvement in the overall cash and deposit balance held by Core Government. Operating Cash and Deposits were \$443.6 million and Reserves and Restricted deposits were \$173.1 million, for a total Cash and Deposits balance of \$616.7 million.

It should also be noted that early savings in areas such as Personnel Costs and Supplies and Consumables may not translate into full year savings and may be due to timing differences.

Balances reflected in the **Statement of Financial Position** for the period ended 31 March 2018 were as follows:

Cash

Cash and Cash Equivalents (including fixed deposits with maturity durations not exceeding 90 days) were \$42.2 million and Marketable Securities (comprised of fixed deposits with maturity durations exceeding 90 days) were \$574.5 million, for a total of \$616.7 million with respect to bank account balances. Due to the significant cash balances, the Government now places funds on longer-term fixed deposits. These longer-term deposits are reflected as Marketable Securities (on the Statement of Financial Position) and are not included in the definition of 'Cash and Cash Equivalents', which only represent deposits that are less than 90 days to maturity.

Borrowings

Central Government debt at the end of the period was \$448.6 million. This was \$34.7 million lower than the debt balance at 31 March 2017.

Revenues

Coercive Revenue

Revenue recorded for the first three months of 2018 were \$16.3 million above budget expectations. This positive variance (the amount of the variances is shown in brackets in the details that follow) was mainly concentrated in Levies on Property (Stamp Duty – Land Transfers \$6.8 million), Import Duties (Other Import Duty, \$1.7 million and Alcoholic Beverages Duty, \$1.0 million), Other Levies on International Trade and Transactions (Cruise Ship Departure Charges, \$1.5 million) and Domestic Levies on Goods and Services (Bank and Trust Licenses, \$4.1 million, Mutual Fund Administrators, \$1.7 million, Tourist Accommodation Charges, \$2.3 million and Traders Licences, \$1.1 million). These positive variances from the budget are offset by negative variances in Other Company Fees, Annual Permanent Resident Work Permit Fees and Partnership Fees.

Stamp duty on Land Transfers was higher due to higher volumes of property transactions coupled with increasing property values. This trend will likely continue through the end of 2018. Banks and Trust Licences Fees were higher than anticipated due to fewer terminations than expected and fees being charged on higher asset values held at the licencees. Mutual Fund Administrators fees were higher due to the increase in volume of funds processed when compared to expectations. Tourist Accommodation Charges were favourable due to all time high arrivals and the residual effects of the eastern Caribbean (BVI and Puerto Rico) being hit by devastating hurricanes last year.

Despite overall favourable results in revenues there were areas that fell short of projected results; in particular, Other Company Fees – Exempt Companies (\$3.5 million negative variance), Annual Permanent Resident Work Permit Fees (\$1.7 million negative variance), Work Permit Fees (\$1.2 million negative variance) and Partnership Fees (\$1.1 million negative variance).

Annual Permanent Resident Work Permit Fees were lower due to the change in classes of permits being applied for at a lesser fee. Other Company Fees – Exempt Companies were unfavourable due to the timing of client payments. Partnership Fees were lower due to an increase in regulated partnerships which attract a lower annual fee. Work Permits Fees are also lower than anticipated due to refunds of cancellations.

Expenses

Personnel Costs

Costs relating to personnel for the first quarter of 2018 amounted to \$70.0 million, which reflects a savings in Personnel Costs of \$4.7 million compared to a budget of \$74.7 million. This favourable variance is the result of several Ministries and Portfolios having vacant posts that have not yet been filled, including positions for the Fire Service, Prison, Public Lands Commission, and Schools.

Supplies and Consumables

Favourably lower than projected expenses of \$19.9 million were recorded for the first three months of the 2018 year, producing a savings of \$7.0 million compared to budgeted costs were \$26.9 million.

The most significant savings related to Purchase of Services which accounts for 72% of the overall variance. Ministries and Portfolios have indicated that spending is anticipated to increase as the year progresses and spending will eventually realign closer to budgeted projections.

Performance of Statutory Authorities and Government Owned Companies

Public Entities recorded a combined net Operating Surplus of \$2.2 million; this was \$3.6 million more favourable than budgeted for the period. Based on the most recent information received from SAGCs, this favourable variance is largely attributed to quarterly results being higher than expected at the Cayman Islands Airports Authority and the Port Authority of the Cayman Islands. These favourable variances were offset by unfavourable performances of Cayman Airways Limited and the Cayman Turtle Centre.

Operating Activities

Net cash inflows from Operating Activities totaled \$178.0 million for the period.

Investing Activities

Investing Activities relating to fixed deposit maturities yielded \$73.1 million.

Additionally, \$267.9 million was used for Investing Activities, of which \$248.7 million relates to placements of fixed deposits. The effect of the movement (i.e. \$248.7 million less \$73.1 million) is an increase in the net amount placed on fixed deposits of \$175.6 million. Additionally, \$19.3 million was utilised for Capital Investment and Expenditures relating to purchases of Property, Plant & Equipment (\$7.7 million) and Equity Investments in Public Entities (\$11.6 million).

Financing Activities

Debt principal repayment was \$2.6 million for the period.

Conclusion

The overall fiscal performance reported for the period shows a net performance position of \$199.0 million, which is 20% (\$34.1 million) higher than budget. This favourable position was due to revenues and expenses out performing initial projections by \$16.3 million and \$14.2 million, respectively. Additionally, Statutory Authorities and Government Owned Companies (SAGC's) contributed a further \$2.2 million to the overall surplus for the Entire Public Sector.

Government's cash position ended at \$616.7 million for the period - \$13.4 million higher than anticipated, mainly as a result of favourable balances in Operating Cash and Deposits. A significant portion of this cash will be used for the bond repayment in 2019.

However, despite the overall favourable results of the period, the higher revenues generated by the annual renewal of licences and registration in the financial sector will now need to be bolstered by the results of other income streams such as duties on imports and tourist accommodation charges throughout the remainder of the year to ensure targeted year-end results are achieved. Additionally, as Ministries anticipate less delays in recruitments and delayed projects begin to come online during the remainder of the year, early savings experienced in expenses will not likely hold true for the remaining three quarters of 2018.
