In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Law (2002 Revision) the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation and commencement

- **1**. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.
 - (2) These Regulations come into force on 4th May, 2020.



Amendment of regulation 2 of the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) Regulations, 2020 – tickets for offences under the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020

- **2.** The *Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) (Ticket) Regulations, 2020,* in these Regulations referred to as the "principal Regulations", are amended in regulation 2(1) as follows —
 - (a) by deleting the words "or 8A of the *Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020*" and substituting the words "or 9 of the *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 Regulations, 2020*"; and
 - (b) by deleting the words "a constable or a special constable" and substituting the words "a constable, special constable or person authorized by the Commissioner".

Amendment of regulation 3 - service and payment of ticket

- **3**. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by repealing paragraph (1) and substituting the following paragraphs
 - "(1) A constable, special constable or person authorized by the Commissioner who serves a ticket shall complete and sign the certificate of service in the ticket stating that the ticket was, on the date set out in the certificate, served on the person whom the constable, special constable or person authorized by the Commissioner had reason to believe committed the offence.
 - (1A) A certificate of service in the ticket shall be evidence that, on the date set out in the certificate, a ticket was served on the person whom the constable, special constable or person authorized by the Commissioner had reason to believe committed the offence.
 - (1B) The Commissioner shall file or cause to be filed with the Clerk of the Court the duplicate of a ticket served under paragraph (1) as soon as practicable after the ticket is served.".



Amendment of regulation 4 - trial after not paying ticket or not agreeing to ticket

- 4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4 as follows
 - (a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words "by signing the request for trial" and substituting the words "by ticking the box for requesting a trial";
 - (b) by repealing paragraph (2) and substituting the following paragraph
 - "(2) As soon as practicable after a person requests a trial under paragraph (1), the Clerk of the Court shall
 - (a) notify the Commissioner of the request;
 - (b) if the Commissioner has not filed the duplicate of the ticket or caused the duplicate of the ticket to be filed in accordance with regulation 3(1B), request the duplicate ticket;
 - (c) fix the time and place of the trial; and
 - (d) notify the defendant and the prosecution, by specifying the time and place of the trial in the ticket.";
 - (c) in paragraph (3), by deleting the words "specified in the ticket" and substituting the words "specified by the Clerk of the Court in the ticket";
 - (d) by repealing paragraph (4); and
 - (e) in paragraph (11) as follows
 - (i) in the chapeau, by deleting the word "Proceedings" and substituting the words "Subject to paragraph (2), proceedings"; and
 - (ii) by repealing subparagraph (a) and substituting the following subparagraph
 - "(a) the Clerk of the Court certifies that the payment of the ticket has not been received within the twenty-eight day period within which it was payable; and".

Repeal and substitution of Schedule 1 – ticket under the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020

5. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing Schedule 1 and substituting the following Schedule —

Amendment of Schedule 2 – ticket offences and fines under the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020

- 6. The principal Regulations are amended in Schedule 2 as follows
 - (a) by deleting the subheading of the Schedule and substituting the following subheading —

"TICKET OFFENCES AND FINES UNDER THE PREVENTION, CONTROL AND SUPPRESSION OF COVID-19 REGULATIONS, 2020"; and

- (b) in the table as follows
 - (i) in Column 1, by deleting item 11 and substituting the following
 - "11. Undertaking travel other than on a day prescribed in regulation 9(2) to any of the following places i.e.
 - (a) a supermarket;
 - (b) a convenience store or minimart;
 - (c) a retail bank, a building society or a credit union;
 - (d) a gas or refilling station to refuel a motor vehicle;
 - (e) a post office;
 - (f) a money remittance facility;
 - (g) an educational institution to collect school supplies; or
 - (h) such other public places as may be specified by the Competent Authority and notified in the *Gazette*, in any other official Government website or official means of communication."; and
 - (ii) in Column 2 as follows
 - (A) in the heading, by deleting the words "the Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulations, 2020" and substituting the words "the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 Regulations, 2020";
 - (B) by deleting the words "Regulation 7(1A)" and substituting the words "Regulation 7(2)"; and
 - (C) by deleting the words "Regulation 8A" and substituting the words "Regulation 9".
