



In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Law (2002 Revision) the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (Travel and Boating) (No.2) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.

**Repeal and substitution of regulation 2 of the Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (Travel and Boating) (No.2) Regulations, 2020 - definitions**

2. The *Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19 (Partial Lifting of Restrictions) (Travel and Boating) (No.2) Regulations, 2020*, in these Regulations referred to as the “principal Regulations”, are amended by repealing regulation 2 and substituting the following regulation —

## **“Definitions**

### **2. In these Regulations —**

“**waters**” means the waters of the territorial seas of the Islands; and

“**wildlife interaction zone**” means —

- (a) the area known as the Sandbar, that is to say the area within a radius of 3/4 of a mile of Latitude 19° 22.536'N Longitude 81° 18.295'W; and
- (b) the area known as Stingray City, that is to say the area within a radius of 3/4 of a mile of Latitude 19°23'18.43'N Longitude 81° 20'45'W.”.

### **Amendment of regulation 4 - conditions for use of boat - Grand Cayman**

- 3.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4(1) by inserting after the words “a person may use a boat” the words “in the waters”.

### **Amendment of regulation 5 - conditions for use of boat - Cayman Brac**

- 4.** The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5(1) by inserting after the words “a person may use a boat” the words “in the waters”.
