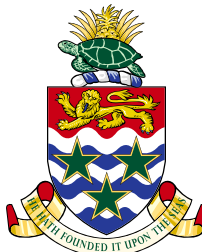

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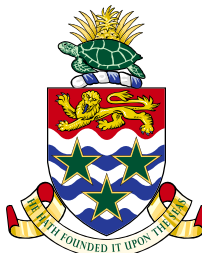

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Public Health Act (2021 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations —

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Control and Management of Covid-19 (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.
(2) Subject to paragraph (3), these Regulations come into force upon publication.
(3) Regulations 2 and 4 come into force on 17th December, 2021.

Amendment of regulation 13 of the Control and Management of Covid-19 (No. 2) Regulations, 2021 - travel from Grand Cayman to Cayman Brac or Little Cayman

2. The *Control and Management of Covid-19 (No. 2) Regulations, 2021*, in these Regulations referred to as the “principal Regulations”, are amended in regulation 13 by repealing paragraphs (2) and (3) and substituting the following paragraphs —
 - “(2) Where a person who is five years of age or older wishes to travel from Grand Cayman to Cayman Brac or Little Cayman, the person may travel without being tested for the virus where the following conditions are satisfied —

- (a) the person has completed an approved vaccine course at least fourteen days prior to the person's date of travel;
 - (b) in the case of a voyage by air, prior to departure of the flight, a vaccination certificate in relation to the person is provided to the relevant airline or an agent of the airline;
 - (c) in the case of a voyage by boat, prior to departure of the boat, a vaccination certificate in relation to the person is provided to a customs and border control officer at the Port Authority; and
 - (d) the person is not showing any respiratory symptoms or symptoms of the virus.
- (3) Where a person who is five years of age or older wishes to travel from Grand Cayman to Cayman Brac or Little Cayman and at least fourteen days prior to the person's date of travel, the person has not completed an approved vaccine course —
- (a) no earlier than the day prior to the departure of the person's flight or boat —
 - (i) a sample from the upper airways to be tested for the virus by a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test; or
 - (ii) an approved test administered by a registered health care facility,shall be obtained in relation to the person;
 - (b) prior to the departure of the person's flight or boat, a medical certificate which —
 - (i) shows that the person had a negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test of a sample from the upper airways, or a negative result of an approved test administered by a registered health care facility, no earlier than the day prior to the departure of the person's flight or boat; and
 - (ii) specifies the name and address of the approved laboratory or registered health care facility where the test was provided,shall be provided to —
 - (A) in the case of a voyage by air, the relevant airline or an agent of the airline; or
 - (B) in the case of a voyage by boat, a customs and border control officer at the Port Authority.”.



Repeal and substitution of Schedule 2 - ticket under the Control and Management of Covid-19 (No. 2) Regulations, 2021

3. The principal Regulations are amended by repealing Schedule 2 and substituting the following Schedule —

Amendment of Schedule 3 - ticket offences and fines

4. The principal Regulations are amended in Schedule 3, item 20 of Column 1, by deleting the words which appear after “(PCR) test” and substituting the words “or a negative result of an approved test, no earlier than the day prior to the departure of the person’s flight or boat.”.
