**Memorandum of
OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill seeks to amend the Public Recorder Act (2010 Revision) to provide for a fifty per cent reduction in fees for older persons for the recording of a deed poll by the Public Recorder and for incidental and connected purposes.

Clause 1 of the Bill provides the short title of the legislation.

Clause 2 amends section 4 of the Public Recorder Act (2010 Revision) to provide for a fifty per cent reduction in fees for older persons for the recording of deed polls by the Public Recorder.
